

TATTOO PRE-VISIT PREPARATION

- ALL tattoo clients must be at least 18 years of age. We will not tattoo minors, regardless of parental consent. You must bring a state or federally issued ID, Driver's License, Passport or Military ID if you wish to be tattooed. No exceptions.

- Bring as many reference materials or pictures as you can if you have a specific idea or design for your tattoo. If you have an appointment, please email the reference pictures and a detailed description of what you would like: staytruebodyart@yahoo.com

- Make sure to eat a solid meal before your appointment, especially if you are receiving a larger tattoo.

- For your safety and the safety of everyone in the shop, do not consume any alcohol, pain medications, blood thinners or any other type of medication that may put your health at risk.

- Consult with your doctor if you have any medical conditions and wish to receive a tattoo. If you must seek medical counsel before tattooing, bring a copy of the clearance letter from your doctor.

- Make sure the area to be tattooed is free from any skin blemishes, rashes, fresh scars and especially sunburns.

- Depending on size and placement, you should make your appointment with enough time to not do any rigorous activity, including swimming for approximately two weeks after receiving your tattoo.
